Dear Families,

Resilience and wellbeing are key factors to ensure a happy and fulfilling future for our young people.

With the support of Hume City Council and The Resilience Project, Penola Catholic College will again partner with Resilient Youth Australia (RYA) to deliver the Resilience Survey to our students.

The Resilience Survey is completely voluntary and anonymous. The online survey collects the self-reported resilience and wellbeing information from our students and will provide valuable information to assist the College and Hume City Council to create and maintain the best culture of wellbeing and resilience that we can. RYA have surveyed more than 350,000 Australian school students aged 8-18 over recent years.

Students will have the opportunity to complete the online survey during an extended Homeroom on Tuesday 24 June 2025. Participation is voluntary and students typically take 20-25 minutes to complete the survey. The data from the survey will be reported in aggregate descriptive form only, by year level and gender, and no individual student responses can be identified.

If any student becomes upset or distressed whilst completing the survey, well-being support will be offered by the College Wellbeing Team.
